Responsibilities and Duties

Education and Programming

- Manage large and small audiences of all ages creating a fun, constructive and safe educational environment.
- Present information about the species we work with.
- Transport wildlife to scheduled programming events in a safe and timely manner. Record and submit mileage to supervisor weekly. Ensure the cleanliness of all transporting materials for continued use.
- Collect service fees for Birthday Programs and Individualized Programming and submit to supervisor.
- Maintain the highest standard of wildlife education as set forth by the guidelines of Buffalo Animal Adventures, Inc.
- Practice the proper methods for safe restraint and handling of our wildlife at all times.

Animal Husbandry and Care

- Perform daily husbandry duties including feeding, maintaining sanitation standards, grooming, hygiene as well as animal enrichment initiatives.
- Maintain records of daily animal husbandry in compliance with the policies and procedures of Buffalo Animal Adventures, Inc. and guidelines set forth by the US Department of Agriculture.
- Maintain safety standards of Buffalo Animal Adventures, Inc. and the US Department of Agriculture.
- Other duties as assigned.
